New addition of Bronchoscopy

On 18th December 2024, Bronchoscopy unit under the Department of Pulmonology was inaugurated by our Director, Mr. K Mathai, Sister Superior, Sr. Gracy Thomas, Medical Superintendent, Dr. Christi Dominic Savio, Nursing Superintendent, Sr. Ancy Anto, Dr. Sivasankari and Dr. Emmanuel James. The addition of this unit gives new scope for diagnosis and treatment of lung diseases.



Bronchoscopy, what is it?

Flexible Bronchoscopy is a minimally invasive procedure used for diagnostic and therapeutic procedure where a flexible, fiber optic bronchoscope is introduced through the patients nose or mouth and advanced into trachea and bronchi. This procedure allows direct visualization of the respiratory tract, from larynx to the distal bronchi. It is a key tool for assessing airways, lungs, and identifying various conditions affecting the respiratory system.

New Addition of FENO (Fractional Exhaled Nitric Oxide)

A new additional diagnostic intervention is added in the Department of Pulmonology called FENO. It is a test used to measure the level of nitric oxide in the breath. It is commonly used to assess airway inflammations, particularly in people with asthma. Higher level of nitric oxide in breath can indicate inflamed airways. FENO is used for – diagnosis of asthma, monitoring asthma, assessing response to Corticosteroids, Predicting exacerbation etc.
